Reminder to drivers:

## Surrendering of departure codes

Your attention is drawn to the requirement in JHR Network Rule CNSY 502 Train Order system, that must be adhered to when reporting departure information to the Network Control Officer;

### Departure

Drivers and track vehicle operators must report departure to the Network Control Officer:

- from departure locations, and
- from reporting locations.

Departure must be reported only after the rearmost vehicle has cleared:

- a BEGIN TRAIN ORDER WORKING sign, or
- a BEGIN NETWORK CONTROL sign, or
- the YARD LIMIT sign at the departure-end of a location specified in the Train Order.
