## Relocation of Parkes Down Landmark Sign

### Implementation

On Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup> December 2017, the following infrastructure changes will be implemented at Parkes.

The Down Landmark Sign (Orange Line) will be relocated 1,165m closer to Sydney.

An updated CNLA West 268 Parkes Sub Terminal and CNLA 269 Parkes Yard are provided with this Safe Notice.

### General Arrangements

All work must be carried out in accordance with the relevant JHR Network Rules and Procedures.

Infrastructure Booking Authority form (CNRF 003) must be compiled in accordance with the JHR Network Rule CNWT 312 and Network Procedure CNPR 704 for infrastructure booked out or into use, existing or newly commissioned equipment changes at locations.

Implementation works must be carried out using an appropriate Work on Track Network Rule listed in CNWT 300.

Work planned for the Rail Corridor must be assessed for safety and its potential to intrude on the *Danger Zone*.
