

## Updated ETW Application for TOA, LOW and WIC

**This Safe Notice supersedes 0039-18**

### Implementation

As of the 4th October 2018, Protection Officers will be able to use the updated ETW Application (Version 2.0) for Track Occupancy Authority (TOA), Lookout Working (LOW) and Work In Corridor (WIC).

### General

- The updated version of the ETW application will be available from the Apple App Store or Google Play Store from the 20th September 2018.
- Version 2.0 of the application can still be used from the 20th September 2018 for Track Occupancy Authorities. The Lookout Working and Work In Corridor functionality will not be switched on until 4th October 2018.
- There has been a minor change to the Track Occupancy Authority home and fulfilment screens whereby the location names are now shown.
- All Protection Officers must have the updated version of the ETW Application by the 4<sup>th</sup> October 2018 to continue to manage Track Occupancy Authorities via the ETW application.
- When a PO is using the ETW application for LOW or WIC, the Network Control Officer name does not need to be recorded on the Worksite Protection Plan (CNRF 014)
- An exception to Network Rule CNWT310 Lookout Working, Protection Officers using the ETW Application to advise Network Control of their lookout working, are not required to speak to the Network Control Officer prior to commencing work in the danger zone.

### Safeworking arrangements

There will be no changes to the Network Rules as a result of the new functionality of ETW.
