

## Notice to Protection Officers

### WARNING



**Several rail traffic limit of authority overruns have occurred in the CRN in recent weeks**

Protection Officers are reminded that each work on track authority or method has minimum mandatory requirements, however additional measures may be adopted.

Protection Officers are encouraged to adopt additional worksite protection measures that will provide rail traffic crews a visual and or audible warning if they overrun their limit of authority.

Work in the Danger Zone must be carried out using one of the protection methods listed in CNWT 300.

The level of safety must not be reduced:

- to allow rail traffic movements, or
- because of a lack of trained workers.



### NOTE

The preferred authorities for working on track are:

- Local Possession Authorities
- Track Occupancy Authorities
