

## Rail Traffic Crew Reporting Requirements

Recently, there has been a number of safety critical incidents involving Rail Traffic Crews that have not been reported to the relevant Network Control Officer (NCO). This Safety Alert is issued to provide guidance to Rail Traffic Crews regarding their reporting requirements.

All incidents must be reported to Network Control, regardless of their impact to the operational rail network. Incidents of increased risk to safety that must be reported immediately, include, but are not limited to:

- actual or potential loss of life or injury, or actual impact to the Environment
- actual or potential damage to or defect in Network infrastructure, or
- damage to or defect in rail traffic, or
- a breach of Network Rules or Procedures.
